AGRA STAFF BRINGS WARMTH TO HAVANA KIDS

Agra staff once again experienced what someone said: “kindness, like a boomerang, always returns.” On Saturday 16 July, the CEO of Agra, Mr. Peter Kazmaier and a group of Agra staff, supporting the Agra/PMK Social Project, paid a visit to the Havana Soup Kitchen to hand over food and blankets to the children. Mr. Paulus Ipinge, a representative of the Moses Garoeb Constituency, attended the handover on behalf of the Councillor, Honorable David Marthin, and expressed his appreciation for “people who have a passion for the needy children who are marginalized by their challenging life circumstances.”

Many of these children face challenges preventing them from being able to attend pre-school or school.

Agra staff volunteered to contribute to the development of the community by contributing to the needy or less-privileged. The Agra/PMK social project, initiated by Mr. Peter Kazmaier, harnesses monthly contributions and personal involvement of Agra staff members to benefit identified charities.

Staff members experienced the joy of giving with a pleasant morning in the company of the children, some parents and the caretaker, Frieda Geises, sharing hearty soup prepared by Agra staff, songs and laughter.
