Safari Den and Namibia Rifle Association host shooting competition

Safari Den will be involved this weekend when shooters take each other on at a special hunter's class target rifle competition on Saturday 11 September 2010 at Luiperdsvallei. This event is organised by the Namibia Rifle Association (NRA), affiliated with the International Shooting Body (ICFRA), to promote the Target Rifle Sport and to motivate individuals to upgrade where necessary to a proper full-bore class and to regularly participate in competitions. Target rifle is the shooting discipline that uses mainly 7.62mm caliber rifles, fired only in the prone position at ranges from 300meter to 900 meter.

Safari Den is Agra's one-stop shop for hunters, gun-owners and shooters as well as outdoor enthusiasts. Events such as this are important for Safari Den to come into contact with clients and support them in their activities. Safari Den therefore assists the NRA to make participation in the event affordable and enjoyable.

The competition starts at 8H30 at Luiperdsvallei and the competition fee of N\$50 includes lunch. Any hunting rifle of pro-am calibre with telescope with a magnification of less than 12 can be used. Participants should bring their own rifles, own ammunition (35 rounds), shooting mattress and rifle stand.

The shooting program will consist of 3 sighters and 7 shots to count at the 200, 300 & 500m, shooting will be under the ICFRA rules and shooting position will be prone position with front and rear rest.
