DO I NEED A LIVESTOCK WATCHDOG

If you are a small-stock farmer whose stock goes to veld unattended and you are experiencing losses to predators, you should consider the use of a livestock watchdog. According to Agra's livestock specialist, farmers must remember that the dog will need correct training, proper feeding and supervision to ensure that it fulfills its duty, does not injure your livestock or chase game. A well-trained and cared for livestock watchdog will reward its owner by guarding and protecting his livestock night and day.

1) WORKING DOGS: GUARDING VS HERDING BEHAVIOUR

When choosing a watchdog for livestock, Agra's livestock specialist advises farmers to be aware that there are two kinds of working-dog behaviour. Firstly there are dogs that display a herding behaviour. They actively move livestock and when they sense danger, they move the stock away from the threat. Secondly, there are dogs that show guarding behaviour. These dogs do not move stock and will not bring the stock home, but they stay with the stock at all times and act as their "bodyguard", actively protecting livestock from predators.

2) I HAVE A WATCHDOG FOR MY LIVESTOCK BUT AM STILL LOSING LIVESTOCK, WHY?

Agra's livestock specialist advises owners that when it comes to livestock watchdogs, size really does matter. Many Namibian goat- or sheepdogs are small, whereas the predators for example cheetah and leopard, are often big. It is unrealistic to expect a small dog to protect the livestock from large predators, this must be done by a large dog. When choosing a dog you need to know what both parents look like to ensure your dog will grow big enough to defend your livestock from threatening predators.

3) PUPPY CARE & VACCINATIONS

Livestock watchdogs need proper protection from deadly diseases. Agra's livestock specialist recommends the following vaccinations for your puppy:

6-8 weeks: initial 5 in 1 vaccination

10-12 weeks: booster 5 in 1 vaccination

14-16 weeks: booster 5 in 1 vaccination & rabies

Adult dogs then receive the 5 in 1 and rabies booster annually.

Puppies should be vaccinated by your vet, but if you do it yourself, make sure that the vaccine stays cool at all times and that your vet shows you how to inject the vaccines correctly.

4) LIVESTOCK GUARDING DOG CARE: TICKS

Ticks carry deadly diseases including tick bite fever and biliary. Symptoms of these diseases in dogs include high fever, listlessness, loss of appetite, pale pink or white gums and tongue, weakness, nose bleed and frequently discharge from eyes and nose. Agra's Livestock Specialist advises you to get the correct dip for your livestock guarding dog from Aua's Vet Med or your nearest Agra branch. Never use livestock dip on your dog, you could kill it! Products such as tick collars, frontline (pour-on) or spot treatment with tick grease are all effective.

5) LIVESTOCK GUARDING DOG CARE: INTERNAL PARASITES - WORMS

Just like livestock, livestock guarding dogs can also suffer from internal parasites such as worms, which can negatively affect your dog's health and ability to work. Signs of worm infestation include a "potbelly" in puppies, while the rest of the puppy is skinny, vomiting, poor coat (dry dull hair), lethargy and diarrhea.

Agra's Livestock Specialist advises you to deworm puppies each time they are vaccinated, thereafter deworm your livestock guarding dog at least twice a year. Ask your vet for suitable products and a schedule for all your dogs.

PERSENEEL VERANDERINGE BY LEWENDE HAWE

Mnr Rainier Els (senior) van Aranos gaan hierdie fasiliteit by Agra huur en die voerkraal privaat bestuur. Die personeel wat met ALCO gemoeid was, verskuif na 'n perseel binne die dorp, wat net regs van Agra se handelstak geleë is. Die laaste paar weke word daar hard gewerk aan die verbetering van die bestaande geboue om aan alle kliënte 'n aangename dienservaring te bied.

Die naam verander na Mariental Lewende Hawe en daar sal met normale lewende hawe werksaamhede voortgegaan word. Reeds vanaf Maandag, 16 Julie is die kantore oop vir besigheid.
