



RULES FOR THE SAFARI DEN FULLY LOADED LEGENDS GROUPING SHOOTING COMPETITION

Participation in this competition will take place according to the rifle, ammunition and equipment described below.

TIMES

The competition will take place from **08h00 to 15h00 on the day of the shooting event**. The organisers reserves the right to change the dates advertised by using their discretion. The prize giving starts after the results are finalized at the range.

COSTS

Standard soft point ammunition:

- N\$150 including three (3) grouping targets and twelve (12) rounds (4x per target).
- N\$50 per additional target.

Higher quality ammunition:

- N\$210 including three (3) grouping targets and twelve (12) rounds (4x per target).
- N\$70 per additional target.

SCORING:

- Only the best three groupings will be used to determine the end result.
- The end result is calculated as the average of the three (3) groupings.
- The 3 groupings must be shot with the same rifle and calibre at the time of the competition.

THE GROUPING

- The grouping is shot from a seated position from a shooting bench over a distance of 100 meters at targets with the ammunition provided by Agra Safari Den.

- Shooters each receive four (4) rounds and may use one round as a fouling shot, fouling shot can be shot at the sight in target.
- Three (3) rounds are used for grouping anywhere on the grouping target within the target framework.
- The grouping is determined by measuring the distance from the centre of the two shots that are the furthest apart.
- Only three shots are allowed on the participant's Agra Safari Den target; less than three shots on the target will disqualify the competitor.
- If there are more than three shots on the target and one shot is clearly different from that of the competitor's own rifle, he / she will not necessarily be disqualified.
- If the fourth shot is of the same calibre, the Range Officer will use his discretion.
- The Range Officer`s decision is final.

QUALIFYING FOR SAFARI DEN FULLY LOADED LEGENDS OF THE YEAR COMPETITION

- All shooters who participated in the scheduled Safari Den Fully Loaded Legends competition, with a grouping smaller than 25mm, qualify for the final.
- The Fully Loaded Legends Final will take place in May, 2020 at the Okahandja Shooting Range.

RIFLE AND TELESCOPES

Only bona fide hunting guns in this specification may be used.

- A Bona-fide hunting rifle is a production rifle with a magazine readily available to dealers and used primarily for hunting purposes.
- Gun barrels must be the normal production type and should not exceed 25mm diameter at the barrel point.
- Silencers allowed
- Maximum Rifle stock width 65mm
- No Muzzle breakers allowed, Silencer with built-in muzzle breaker is allowed
- The minimum length of the barrel should 20 Inches. The length of the barrel is measured by placing a cleaning rod in the barrel with the rifle lock closed. The cleaning rod is pushed up to the front of the lock and marked where it comes to the end of the barrel. The cleaning rod is then measured from one point to the mark to determine the length of the barrel.
- Telescopes with a maximum magnification of 12X may be used. Telescopes that exceed this magnification should be set at 12X and sealed during the competition.
- Only shooting tables, sandbags and shooting rest provided on the day of the competition may be used.
- Rifle Slings and swivels must be removed from the rifle

TARGETS

- There is no limit to the number of targets that a shooter can buy.

AMMUNITION

- No other ammunition except the ammunition provided by Safari Den may be used.

RELAY TEAMS

- Shooters will be divided into relay teams. A maximum of 10 shooters may form a relay group. Shooters may participate in more than one calibre category.
- Shooters must take their positions at the firing point where Range Officers will issue marked ammunition to shooters and collect the marked bullet cases again after the relay.

PRIZES

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize will be awarded to the overall winners (Aggregate of the 3 groupings)
- Prizes will be awarded per calibre for smallest grouping of the day.

Should a participant not be present at the prize giving, he / she will forfeit the prize. A prize may not be transferred to another participant.

COMPETITOR:

The competitor must be the lawful owner of the rifle and must have his/her firearms license with him/her.

Juniors may take part under supervision of the parent.

RANGE COMMITTEE

The Range Committee consists of members as agreed on the day. The committee's decisions are final. The committee will, among other things, make decisions on the admissibility of guns, the sealing of telescopes and any other controversial issues.

SAFETY

- Safety precaution measures will be strictly applied by the Range Officer.
- The Range rules of the hosting club will apply for the competition.
